“They Are Your Inalienable Rights!”*



Our forefathers explained, in the Declaration of Independence, that the Laws of Nature reveal the inalienable rights that Nature’s God has given to individuals. These rights include life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness (property). These founders also knew that governments either secure these rights or destroy them. When governments habitually destroy inalienable rights, the people then have a right and responsibility to change the government. This requires that the people use the Laws of Nature to defend their inalienable rights. But, since the words of Nature’s God about the Laws of Nature are not commonly taught; life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness have suffered to the same degree.

Therefore, the course titled, “They Are Your Inalienable Rights!” is being offered toward restoring and building upon our Constitutional heritage by informing and motivating educational, professional, and political action in every state.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course prepares citizens of North Dakota (and beyond) to defend their inalienable rights in many influential areas. The person completing this course will understand what Nature’s God says about government, civil law, economics, and education. Professions such as law, banking, medicine, agriculture, elder care and social work are used to illustrate where inalienable rights can be restored in state and federal government context. The theological basis for inalienable rights are explained and contrasted with modern influential philosophies.

NUMBER OF CREDITS: One credit as described. A two credit version of this course is also available which requires oral presentations and written articles from each participant.

DUAL CREDIT: High school students may take this course as part of their college curriculum.
